### **What is AIM?**

AIM stands for Advancing in Missions and is a local, intensive mission leadership program for high school students within Friendship Baptist Association. We are now in our 11th year of providing this program.

### **What will AIM missionaries be doing?**

In addition to working summer camps, students will be participating in several planned mission and evangelism projects in the association.

### **Is this all?**

No...AIM is designed to be an immersion program. Missionaries will be challenged to grow in discipleship through Bible study, worship, prayer, mentoring relationships, accountability groups, and hands-on experience.

### **Who can apply?**

High school students (completed 9th grade– 2020 graduates) who are committed Christians. Applicants must be a member of a SBC church and able to commit to serve for 4-6 weeks this summer. In addition, students must exhibit personal and emotional maturity, and have a sense of God's call or leadership in their life.

### **What are the program requirements?**

1. Attend the Camp Missionary Training Meeting.
2. Participate in 4-6 weeks during the program. (Please see the application for details.)

### **Is there any cost to do AIM?**

No. We take care of all the expenses and provide a small stipend for spending money.

### **How do I apply?**

Fill out the AIM application, have your pastor/youth pastor sign the recommendation, and return it to the FBA office by May 4, 2020. Interviews will be set up for May 9, 2020. We will notify applicants of their acceptance after this date.
